


Diagram plan of proposed range of play experiences



CLAPTON COMMON PLAYGROUND



- Existing swings retained.
- Existing mounding extended and re-profiled.
- New gated entrance created onto pedestrianised section of Clapton Common with new path and seating area within the playground.
- Timber-topped seating with integrated bug-hotels to replace existing log seating.
- New disk spinner.
- Loose bark-chip and teepee den area with cube seating.
- New climbing frame with slide, suitable for under 5s.
- Timber play trail extending over the mound.
- Stile over timber fence, connecting the under- and over-5s play areas.
- Timber play/trim trail over the mound.
- Picnic bench.
- Climbing frame with towers, slide, climbing logs and nets.
- New basket swing.
- New planting to provide greater definition to the play area and wildlife interest.
- Areas managed with a relaxed mowing regime and over-seeded with wild-flower seed to provide seasonal definition to the play area and wildlife interest.


