


# HAGGERSTON PARK

## PLAY AREA IMPROVEMENTS

We are improving Haggerston Park's play area! We are making it bigger and adding some more equipment so that it appeals to a wider age range of children and is more accessible. We would love to hear what you think.



- Ⓐ The swings, see-saw, slide, wobble bridge and spinning bowl are all staying in place
- Ⓑ A new sand pit will provide a home for a sailing boat and a new rocker
- Ⓒ A new path and safety surfacing will improve access to the swings and a new trampoline
- Ⓓ A balance rope up the existing mound activates the area for further play
- Ⓔ The two sections of the play area will be linked by an enclosed net bridge over the pathway
- Ⓕ Logs, tree trunks and boulders dotted around the play area will provide routes through the space and provide spots to climb, sit and play
- Ⓖ A shipwrecked boat climbing frame will provide adventures for older children
- Ⓗ A new tower and slide
- Ⓘ Areas of planting along with a hedge and some trees provide seasonal colour and new habitats
- Ⓙ Additional bench
- Ⓚ Relocated ping pong table
