**Re: Zone T Review Consultation Implementation**

Following on from the publication of the Zone T Review summary outcome, Parking Services have completed the statutory consultation for the zone and will now implement the recommended changes. The current operational hours of **Monday to Saturday 8.30 am to 6.30 pm** will change to **Monday to Friday 10.00 am to 12.00 pm (noon)**.

Parking Services will implement the changes throughout the zone between **21st March until 26th March 2021**.

During this time, all parking signs, visitor parking terms and conditions and pay and display machine information will be updated to reflect the new hours of operation.

The Council will also implement design changes on **Alkham Road** and **Chardmore Road** between 24th March and 26 March. Parking suspension signs will be erected on site a minimum of 5 working days prior to the start of the suspension to inform you of the dates of the lining. Please be advised that any vehicles parked within the suspended bays may be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN).

Additional bay type changes which do not require parking suspensions will also take place on the following roads:

- Braydon Road
- Cazenove Road
- Darenth Road
- Lynmouth Road
- Portland Avenue

During the implementation process, Parking Services will be changing all shared use bays to 1 hour maximum stay with 1 hour no return. This is due to the reduction in the hours of operation of the parking zone and to prevent commuter parking. There will be minimal impact to residents and businesses as existing Zone T permits will continue to be valid in these bays when the new hours of operation take effect.

## Implementation of changes

### **Sunday 21 March 2021**

The changes to the hours of operation will be implemented on all visitor parking bays across the zone. This means that all signage, terms and conditions for visitors and pay and display information will be updated.

### **Monday 22nd March to Friday 26th March 2021**

The changes to the hours of operation from **Monday to Saturday 8.30 am to 6.30 pm (current hours)** to **Monday to Friday 10.00 am to 12.00 pm (noon)** will be implemented on all permit bays.

## Enforcement of parking restrictions

All visitor parking restrictions (shared use bays) will be enforceable as of **22nd March 2021**.

Enforcement on all permit bays between 22nd March until 26th March 2021 will be carried out as and when the new restrictions have been implemented on each street. Please check the signs before you park and ensure that you display a valid permit or visitor voucher.

All other restrictions which are enforceable at all times such as double yellow lines, disabled bays, loading bays, car clubs, ambulance bays, doctors bays will be enforced as normal as the new hours of operation do not apply to these restrictions.

## How will the new change in operational hours affect me?

Residents and businesses with an existing Zone T parking permit will not need to do anything, the current Zone T permit can be used as normal.

Visitors to the zone during the new hours of operation will need to only display a valid voucher or pay and display parking session during the hours of Monday to Friday 10am to 12 noon.

## Visitor Vouchers

If you have any books of full, unused and undamaged one day visitor vouchers, Parking Service will replace these for a book of 2hr vouchers free of charge. Please return these vouchers, along with a cover letter containing your name and address by **22 March 2021** to:
