



Parking Zone (P) Review Consultation Results



Why have I received this summary leaflet?

In August 2014, Parking Services consulted all residents and businesses in Zone P (Victoria Village) to find out whether the parking controls were continuing to meet your needs.

We would like to thank all those who returned their questionnaire and provided feedback during the consultation.

Your views have been very important to us and have helped us shape the parking needs of the area.

Please find below a summary of the consultation results and our final decision.

Your feedback and final decision

During the public consultation we asked whether you were satisfied with;

- The current hours of operation for the Parking Zone (PZ);
- Whether you had any other comments on the design of parking controls

Operational Hours

During the consultation we asked if you were satisfied with the current hours of operation.

Out of the 721 responses received, only 683 respondents answered the question regarding their preferred hours of operation. There was almost an even split in the overall responses received regarding the hours of operation. 48% (325) of responses were in favour of the current hours of controls and 52% (358) in favour of shorter hours of control.

Further analysis of feedback on a street by street basis showed that the majority of roads in the western section of Zone P displacement area (West of Lauriston Road, excluding Handley Road and Moulins Roads) were in favour of shorter hours of control, whilst the majority of the roads in the eastern section of Zone P, east of Lauriston Road (except Banbury Road) were in favour of longer hours of control.

Final Decision

To ensure that the hours of operation in the area continue to meet the needs of the residents and businesses in the community, the Council has taken the decision to;

- Maintain the current hours of operation of Monday to Friday 8.30am to 5.00pm in all streets to the east of Lauriston Road (excluding Lauriston Road and sections of Victoria Park Road up to its junction with Wetherell Road) (see orange area on the map provided)
- Modify the hours of operation to Monday to Friday 10am to 12 noon in all roads to the west of Lauriston Road (including Lauriston Road) (see green area on the map provided)
- Move Handley Road and Moulins Road into Zone D(s) (see pink area on the map provided)

Some streets which supported shorter hours such as Banbury Road and Edenbridge Road have been included in the area with longer hours due to the fact that the surrounding streets support the longer hours. We were unable to implement shorter hours on these streets due to the need to create a logical boundary.

The decision to allocate a street within a particular operational area is based on the feedback received as well as other factors such as creating a logical boundary.

Please see enclosed map which shows the final design and boundaries.

Parking design

During the consultation we provided you with the opportunity to include general comments on changes you would like to see to the design of your zone. The majority of comments received were in relation to the hours of control within your zone rather than specific bay changes.

363 respondents provided general comments, 20% of which were in relation to the hours of operation, stating that you were satisfied with the current hours of operation in the area. Other general comments were in relation to the need for additional visitor parking bays and disabled bays.

In response to requests for additional visitor parking provisions, the Council is recommending to change the permit bays outside numbers 202 to 220 Victoria Park Road to shared use bays. These bays are within close proximity to local businesses as well as the new Mossbourne Victoria Park Academy School and will therefore provide parking for both visitors and permit holders. There is sufficient permit parking on this road for all permit holders and so this proposal will not have any adverse impact on permit holders.

Parking Services will also be converting the shared use bays on Shafton Road to permit bays as the difference in the hours of operation and the close proximity of similar bays operating with different times on Victoria Park Road may lead to confusion to motorists. This is unlikely to have any impact on the local businesses as additional visitor parking has been provided on Victoria Park Road and parking will be free after 12 noon in most streets in the area.

Disabled Parking

During the consultation, the Council received requests for disabled bays from some roads.

Unfortunately, disabled bays cannot be implemented based on general comments received from the public. The Council is only able to implement disabled bays for individuals who have followed the application process and have been assessed / referred by the Council's mobility team.

Pay and Display

The Pay and display prices in the Zone P displacement area will be amended to match those in Gore Road.

In addition, to ensure that commuter parking is discouraged and parking in the area is not abused by visitors, the pay and display and shared use bays will only have a 1 hour maximum stay with 2 hours no return, to match restrictions in existing Zone P two hour zone.

How will the changes affect me?

Residents

No significant changes have been made to the bay design in the area and residents will still be able to park with their permits in all shared use and permit bays. Any minor changes can be seen on the user friendly map provided.

As changes have been made to the hours of operation in some streets, we have listed these below to make it easier for residents to identify what the hours of operation are for their street.

The following streets will maintain the current hours of operation of **Monday to Friday 8.30am to 5.00pm**.

The following streets will have the operational hours modified to **Monday to Friday 10am to 12 noon. This includes all roads to the west of Lauriston Road (including Lauriston Road).**

You will not be required to make any changes to your permit or visitor vouchers as your current permits will still be valid to park in the area.

Handley Road and Moulins Road

As a result of feedback received from residents, Handley Road and Moulins Road will be incorporated in to the neighbouring Parking Zone D(s). The Zone D(s) hours of operation are **Monday to Saturday 8.30am to 6.30pm.**

Pending statutory consultation (Traffic Management Order Process), if this proposal goes ahead, all residents will need to exchange their Zone P permit for a Zone D(s) permit once these roads have been moved to Zone D(s). Zone P resident permits and unused visitor vouchers will be exchanged for a Zone D(s) free of charge.

The Council will write to all residents on these roads separately once the traffic order process has been completed to advise on the next step.

Businesses

The shorter hours of control on Lauriston Road and Victoria Park Road will help support all local businesses. Parking will be free of charge for all visitors to these roads after 12 noon which may help encourage further trade.

All visitor parking bays will have a maximum stay of 1 hour with a no return within 2 hours during the hours of operation. In addition the pay and display charges will change to bring these in line with the existing Zone P (Gore Road).

You will not be required to make any changes to your permit if you hold a business permit.

What happens next?

15th December 2014

Statutory Consultation to commence. All proposed changes will be advertised in Hackney Today. All residents and businesses will have the opportunity to comment on the proposed changes for a period of 21 days. Any comments will be considered and final decision made on what proposals are to be implemented.

February 2015

Residents and businesses of Moulins Road and Handley Road will be provided with further information on what the outcome of the statutory consultation will be.

March 2015

Parking Services plan to commence implementation of the proposed changes (pending statutory consultation).
