What is Future Shoreditch?

Hackney Council is in the early stages of preparing an Area Action Plan for Shoreditch, called FUTURE SHOREDITCH. The Plan will set out a vision for what Shoreditch will look like in 2034 and the planning policies to guide and manage future development and investment in the area. Once adopted, this plan will be an important document when making planning decisions in Shoreditch.

Why Shoreditch?

Shoreditch has experienced phenomenal growth over the past 20 years, with businesses and services continuing to be drawn to the area along with new residents and visitors. This growth presents great opportunities as well as challenges, particularly as rents rise and the supply of affordable workspace struggles to match demand.

Future Shoreditch will help to ensure that the pressure for new development does not erode the special qualities and character of Shoreditch that continues to draw businesses, residents and visitors to the area in the first place.

Residential communities are an integral part of Shoreditch, yet many feel they are increasingly disadvantaged by the type, scale and pace of change facing the area. Therefore Future Shoreditch is not just about guiding physical growth, but also providing a co-ordinated approach to regeneration to create a better overall quality of place and life for all.

The consultation process – What's happened so far?

There have been two earlier rounds of consultation to help us understand the key issues, challenges and opportunities facing Shoreditch:

- March May 2017, Launch consultation –
 Key issues, challenges and opportunities
 facing Shoreditch.
- July 2017, Community workshops –
 Three community workshops in July, developed in response to the outcomes of the launch consultation and analysis of the area.


This stage: The Issues and Options Document

Future Shoreditch is still at a very early stage of development, with the Issues and Options document presenting a vision for the future. It identifies a number of key planning issues and options, informed by previous consultations and evidence-based work, which will need to be considered by the Council.



Future Shoreditch draft boundary

The boundary area of the Area Action Plan is largely defined to the West, South & East by the borough boundaries of the London Borough of Islington, The City of London and the London

Borough of Tower Hamlets respectively. The Northern boundary falls within the Borough of Hackney, and this provides more flexibility in terms of where the line should be drawn.



What are the issues and proposed options?

Managing Growth – Shoreditch is expected to experience continued growth over the years to 2034 and there is a need to understand how best this scale of change can be managed to benefit everyone. Job creation, new homes and supporting infrastructure will all need to be delivered through any development. Delivering new homes – Shoreditch is a highly desirable place to live and as such purchase and rental prices are continuing to climb.	The proposed options explore how best to deliver a mix of different types and size of homes in Shoreditch that responds to the needs of Hackney residents.	62-65
Shopping in Shoreditch – Shoreditch falls within the Central Activities Zone which will direct retail, leisure, cultural, tourism and commercial activity to the area. There is a need to manage the distribution of this activity to find an appropriate balance and mix of uses in Shoreditch.	The proposed options consider the amount, type and size of retail space that should be promoted in Shoreditch and where this should be located.	66-71

The contrasting day, evening and night-time economy – There is a need to manage the evening and night-time economy in terms of its offer and effect on local people. Shoreditch is home to many bars, night clubs and licensed premises and the anti-social behaviour that is frequently associated with such uses. In contrast, there is a lack of diversity in terms of cultural, community and leisure uses.	 The proposed options set out how the Plan can manage night time economy uses including; Creating a more diverse and inclusive night time economy Promoting the 'Agent of Change' principle Managing the concentration of licensed premises (% thresholds within defined areas) Considering locations where licensed premises would be more appropriate in Shoreditch 	72-75
The design of new development and the importance of heritage assets – Market pressures and demand for modern, large-scale commercial space is seeing a large number of applications for high density and tall buildings in Shoreditch. The area is home to a variety of special character and heritage assets. There is concern over the appropriateness of this type development in Shoreditch and its impact on local character and heritage assets.	 The proposed options proposed include: Continuing the protection and enhancement of existing Conservation Areas; Potential designation of Character Areas to set out unique sub-area policy guidance for identified Character Areas Setting out an approach to building heights in Shoreditch. 	76-81
Traffic management – Shoreditch is a main gateway into London that suffers noise and air pollution associated with busy roads and congestion. Much of this is through traffic that moves through the area on route to somewhere else. This is creating an unsafe, unhealthy and unwelcoming environment in Shoreditch.	The options proposed include a range of traffic demand management measures and measures to reduce vehicle movements.	82-85
Sustainable travel and public realm – Parts of Shoreditch are home to poor quality streets and public spaces that overall lack much green space. There is a desire to see improvements in the sustainable travel options into and around the area. This includes promoting walking, cycling and public transport and how this can be supported through an enhanced quality of public realm.	The options proposed include a range of measures to improve and enhance the public realm and promote sustainable travel through: The reallocation of road space/parking spaces; Encouraging improvements to existing public spaces/open space and encouraging new green space and pocket parks Requiring improvements to the pedestrian and cycle environment in Shoreditch.	86-91
Call for sites – The consultation on Issues and Options will include a 'call for sites' exercise to identify sites within the area that may have the potential for development over the Plan period, up to 2033.	This process will enable the community and stakeholders to suggest sites in the Plan boundary and indicate preferred uses for these sites.	92-93
