

# Improvements to Hoxton starting this spring

## 1 Arden Estate

From spring 2025, we will be introducing landscaping improvements adjacent to Cordelia House, including trees, herbs, native and fruiting hedges.

# **2** Hoxton Community Garden

From 17 March, we will be improving the entrance to the garden by installing high quality pavement, making the main entrance from Hoxton Street more prominent. Future upgrades include widened paths, accessible seating and picnic tables and improved fencing.

## **3 Hoxton Market**

We will introduce electric power for market-related events and street food stalls, as well as a new colour scheme for gazebos.

#### **4** Hoxton Hall


Following consultation workshops, we will introduce high quality pavement at the hall's entrance and a raised table to accommodate an informal crossing. There are also opportunities to make the footway opposite the hall greener.

# **5** Wayfinding

Workshops will take place over plans to install new co-ordinated estate maps from the summer to improve navigation to and from the estate blocks.

# **6** Planting street trees

In the spring, trees will be planted on Hoxton Street and nearby streets and estate land to improve air quality.



# 7 Geffrye Estate

We are introducing bulbs and wildflowers, as well as native and fruiting hedges, trees and fruit trees, bee posts, bug hotels and log piles to lawns on the estate this spring to improve biodiversity.

#### 8 Welcome mural

We are planning to engage the community in plans for new artwork on the blank wall facing Falkirk Street this summer to welcome people to the area.

## 9 Shoreditch Library

New high quality pavement will be introduced this spring at the library's entrance. We will extend the pavement in front of the library and opposite. There are also opportunities to make this area greener.
