



Start of works notification

Central London Cycle Grid: New North Road – Eagle Wharf Road – Poole Street Junction

Improvements on the Central London Cycle Grid (CLCG) in Hoxton have been in progress since February 2017 and have seen the completion of the Shepherdess Walk – Murray Grove junction where new signal controlled pedestrian crossings were installed.

This will be followed by improvement works to the New North Road – Eagle Wharf Road – Poole Street junction.

The improvements at the New North Road – Eagle Wharf Road - Poole Street junction will include:

- Introducing new traffic signals with signal controlled pedestrian and cycle crossings at the junction.
- Retaining the 'No Entry' point for vehicular traffic at Eagle Wharf Road – New North Road junction.
- Introducing a 'Right Turn Restriction' for existing traffic coming out of Eagle Wharf Road.
- Introducing a 'No Entry' point to restrict vehicular traffic from New North Road turning into Poole Street.
- Removing the contraflow cycle lane at Poole Street between New North Road and Imber Street to allow 2 way traffic to the New North Road junction.
- Implementing public realm improvements at Eagle Wharf Road and Poole Street with new trees, waiting and loading restrictions.

Construction and Traffic Management

The works at the New North Road - Eagle Wharf Road – Poole Street junction are scheduled to start during the week commencing 26 June 2017 for 16 weeks in total.

The improvements will start at Eagle Wharf Road and will last for up to 8 weeks followed by works at Poole Street from mid-August to the end of September 2017.

Traffic Management

The improvements at Eagle Wharf Road and Poole Street will be carried out under suitable traffic management with localised road closures and diversion routes when required.

Elsewhere

Works at **New North Road – East Road Junction** are scheduled to start during the week commencing **18 June 2017** for up to 16 weeks.


Thames Water repairs may affect the resurfacing of the New North Road junction as it is currently being used as a diversion route.

Works at Poole Street will be coordinated with the ongoing developers' works at the **Colville Estate**.

The programming of the CLCG improvements on site may be affected by the above works to ensure the smooth flow of traffic at all times.
