

Works Notification

Bus Priority Scheme for Kenton Road Bus Stand

Following consultation with residents and businesses during November / December 2021, plans to improve the reliability on bus routes 30 and 425 have been approved.

The decision has taken into consideration feedback received during the public consultation.

What works will be carried out

The redundant bus stop will be converted to a bus stand and the following changes on the section of Kenton Road opposite Queen Anne Road will be made to enable buses to turn around safely and to improve the local environment:

- Removing two parking spaces at the entry point (one on each side) where buses turn into the triangle area from Valentine Road
- Re-aligning the kerb in Kenton Road to create more carriageway space to allow buses to exit the triangle safely
- Introducing "No waiting and loading" restrictions around the Kenton Road triangle
- Creating a new green space on the existing build-out in Kenton Road.

Construction and traffic management

The works are scheduled to start in the week commencing Monday 13 February 2023 and, weather permitting, will take approximately two weeks to complete.

As part of the works, a road closure may be in place at the northern end of the Kenton Road triangle. Access will be maintained for residents throughout the duration of the works.

Please avoid parking in the area of the works. The parking bays on the Kenton Road triangle area will be suspended during the works, and offending vehicles may have to be removed.


