

## **Works Notification**

# Leonard Street (west) – Modal Filter & Public Realm Improvement Scheme

Following consultation with residents in February / March 2021, plans to install a modal filter and improve the public realm at Leonard Street (west) have been approved.

The decision has taken into consideration feedback received during the public consultation.

#### What works will be carried out?

- Making Leonard Street to the west of Kiffen Street 'no entry' to motorised traffic
- Planting several trees where possible on either side of the footway and carriageway to enhance the public realm and help improve air quality
- Introducing informal seating (natural boulders) to allow locals and visitors to rest and enjoy the new space
- Introducing additional cycle parking where possible
- Introducing a westbound cycle lane along the existing eastbound cycle lane to avoid user conflicts within the filtered area
- Introducing creative tree guards that will also function as street furniture (informal seating) for pedestrians to rest

- No removal of parking spaces will be necessary as part of this scheme
- The existing Santander bikes will be suspended for the duration of the works.

### Construction and traffic management

The works are scheduled to start in the week beginning 13 March 2023 and will take approximately 10 weeks to complete (weather permitting).

As part of the works road closures will be in place on Leonard Street between the junctions of Tabernacle Street and Kiffen Street. Local access will be retained via Paul Street, Clere Street and Tabernacle Street.

Please avoid parking in the area of the works, which will be clearly marked with signs, cones and barriers, as offending vehicles may have to be removed.
