## PLAY AREA IMPROVEMENTS



We are improving Butterfield Green's play space. The stream play space in the centre of the park is well loved. The proposals want to complement the existing space whilst resolving the issues in maintaining the existing water play feature. We would love to hear what you think about the proposals.

- (A) The wobbly bridge will stay in place and is joined by some large logs, which will provide alternative climbing routes across the dry creek, as well as a place to sit
- (B) The stream channel will be filled in with river stones, additional boulders and planting to create a dry creek bed
- (C) A new water source will replace the existing hand pump, retaining water play whilst minimising ongoing maintenance
- (D) A new contoured non slip surface will channel the water down to the dry creek
- (E) Additional seating.
